RSKTKR GUNFIGHTER

for the LEO (Off Duty and Plain Clothes Carry for Law Enforcement Officers)

Course Description:

This comprehensive training program, designed for Law Enforcement Officers, focuses on enhancing skills crucial for off-duty or plain-clothes concealed carry situations. Led by experienced instructors, the course integrates verbal communication, firearms proficiency, and defensive tactics to ensure officers are well-prepared for diverse and challenging scenarios.

Key Components:

1. Verbal Communication Skills:

- Effective communication is paramount in diffusing potential threats. This module emphasizes verbal de-escalation techniques, enabling officers to handle situations with tact and diplomacy.

- Role-playing scenarios provide practical experience in managing interactions, ensuring officers can confidently navigate verbal challenges.

2. Firearms Proficiency:

- Rigorous firearms training is central to this course. Officers will undergo advanced marksmanship drills, emphasizing accuracy and speed in simulated real-world scenarios.

- Concealed carry techniques will be extensively covered, ensuring officers are adept at accessing and utilizing their firearms while maintaining situational awareness.

3. Defensive Tactics:

- This segment focuses on hands-on defensive tactics tailored for off-duty encounters. Officers will learn techniques for defending against assailants at Extreme Close Quarters, and safely managing physical altercations.

- Scenario-based training will immerse participants in realistic situations, honing their ability to make split-second decisions and employ effective defensive maneuvers.

Course Objectives:

- Develop enhanced situational awareness in off-duty environments.
- Improve verbal communication skills to manage and de-escalate potential conflicts.
- Enhance concealed carry techniques and firearms proficiency.
- Instill confidence in officers to effectively respond to various off-duty scenarios.
- Foster a proactive and protective mindset among law enforcement personnel.

Prerequisites:

Participants must be active Law Enforcement Officers and members of ATOA

This course equips officers with the skills and mindset needed to navigate Off-duty or UC situations, emphasizing the importance of proactive protection and effective response strategies.

Equipment and Gear Requirements-

- 1. Range PPE ie Hearing Protection and Eyewear
- 2. Range bag for maintenance or cleaning of weapon system
- 3. 300 rounds of Range ammo
- 4. Water or preferred beverage for hydration
- 5. Folding chair
- 6. Duty or Off duty pistol in a Concealed Carry Holster, Off body carry Bags are ok as are Belly bands or Thunderwear.
- 7. Mag holder for one spare mag (two mag or more holders are okay as well) or Speedloaders
- 8. Civilian clothing you would normally wear Off duty or Undercover (Pistol and Mag Holders must be concealed).
- 9. Appropriate Range Footwear (Closed toe shoes, no Flip flops)
